

**FIVCO REVOLVING LOAN FUND PROGRAM  
STATEMENT OF ASSURANCES**

The applicant will comply with:

1. Access for the Handicapped: If an RLF finances a construction project to which the public will have access, the applicant must insure that accessibility to the handicapped is provided.
2. Davis-Bacon: Construction financed in whole or in part by the RLF must meet the requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act, as amended (40 U.S.C. 276a-276a-5). With respect to prevailing wage rates.
3. Relocation: The location of loan projects must be within the eligible project areas Boyd, Carter, Lawrence, Elliott and Greenup. The loan will be recalled if the project activity is moved from the area. Businesses relocating jobs from another labor area are not eligible borrowers.
4. The National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. S 4321 et.seq.) and 24 CRF Part 58, and in connection with its performance of environmental assessments under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, comply with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (16 U.S.C. 468), Executive Order 11593, and the Preservation of Archeological and Historical Data Act of 1974 (16 U.S.C. 469a-1, [et.seq.] by:
  - (a) Consulting with the State Historic Preservation Officer to identify properties listed in or eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places that are subject to adverse effects (see 36 CFR Part 800.8) by the proposed activity; and
  - (b) Complying with all requirements established by the State to avoid or mitigate adverse effects upon such properties.
5. Executive Order 11988, Floodplain Management;
6. Executive Order 11990, Protection of Wetlands;
7. Section 202(a) of the Flood Disaster Protection Act of 1973 (42 U.S.C. 4106) as it relates to the mandatory purchase of flood insurance for identified special flood hazard areas;
8. The Endangered Species Act of 1973, as amended;
9. The Fish and Wildlife Coordination Act of 1958, as amended;
10. The Wild and Scenic Rivers Act of 1968, as amended;
11. The Safe Drinking Water Act of 1974, as amended;
12. The Clean Air Act of 1970, as amended;
13. The Federal Water Pollution Control Act of 1972, as amended;
14. The Clean Water Act of 1977; and
15. The Solid Waste Disposal Act, as amended by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act of 1976.

The applicant hereby certifies that it will comply with the above stated assurances. Now adherence to above requirements will subject this loan to recall and become fully payable.
